

ESSU Criteria for Representation or Discretionary Grants

GB Representation Grants

- Applications for a Representation Grant will be considered where the applicant has been selected by British Shooting to compete in an international shooting competition representing Great Britain. Applicants are required to provide written evidence of invitation to represent Great Britain.
- Applicants must be a current fully paid-up member of the English Smallbore Shooting Union (ESSU).
- Applicants must be a member of either TENS or an England Rifle or Pistol Academy
- Applicants must be under the age of 21 on the date of the competition or be in full time education.
- Applicants can make no more than two applications in any ESSU financial year.
- Only one award to a maximum value of £500.00 will be made to an individual within any ESSU financial year.
- In the event that the applicant does not compete in the selected event any grant awarded must be re-paid in full within 3 months of the date of the competition.

Discretionary grant

- Academy Rifle & Pistol Managers can make application for a non-refundable Discretionary Grant on behalf of an athlete, to assist with their training.
- The Athlete must be a current fully paid-up member of the English Smallbore Shooting Union (ESSU).
- Only one award to a maximum value of £500.00 will be made to an athlete within any ESSU financial year.
